DID YOU KNOW?

"Tutoring services that are additional to the primary education of a person with a learning disability or an impairment in mental functions, and paid to a person in the business of providing these services to individuals who are not related to the person. A medical practitioner must certify in writing that these services are needed."

- Canada Revenue Agency

In order to claim our services you must have a psychoeducational report/assessment provided by a medical practitioner that states that you or your child requires executive functioning support or tutoring.

Acceptable medical practitioners include but are not limited to:

- Audiologists
- Licensed or registered practical nurses
- Occupational therapists
- Psychological associates
- Psychologists
- Registered nurses
- Registered psychological nurses
- Social workers
- Speech language pathologists
